At the Thursday meeting of the Leadership Committee of The Republican Party of Brazos County, the committee carried a unanimous vote calling for your immediate resignations.

This action is taken so that full faith may be restored in the TAMU CR program, to not only carry forward with new business, but to restore the TXFCR Chapter of the College Republicans on the A&M campus. The recent discussion to effectively gavel out of affiliation with the governing board of TXFCR and therefore, any affiliation with the Republican Party of Texas, is viewed as an egregious violation of party principals, and demonstrates a lack of clear judgement.

The Leadership Committee is concerned that you are shutting down all channels of communication and affiliation with the local party, the state party, the TXFCR, and CRNC.

Therefore, the reasons outlined above are what led to the unanimous vote held by the Leadership Committee calling for your immediate resignations. Good luck in all of your future endeavors.
