Dear Mr. Isenhour,

The Leadership Committee of the Republican Party of Brazos County has unanimously approved a vote of no confidence for you.

Your actions as Chairman of the TAMU College Republicans are not demonstrative of a leader of young men and women, violate Republican Party principals, and have led to widespread concern about the direction of the College Republicans under your tenure.

Some of the actions that have led to this discussion are.

- Lack of Transparency in Conducting TAMU CR Business.
- Choosing Delegates to the State Convention who weren't involved with the TAMU CR's, one of which led to a direct conflict of interest with a candidate for state office.
- Hostile language and attitude toward the local party.
- Failure to Attend Executive Committee Meetings, resulting in no representation by a board member of the CR, although, CR have been on every agenda since you took office.
- Showing up late to the State Convention. (Missing all of the Morning Session)- Leading to your non-participation as a delegate.
- Your recent ill- planned "Revolt" of The TAMU CR from the TXFCR. This defederation will leave A&M with no representation in the State Party.

This is the first measure and/or action against you. Additional measures may be taken that could be a permanent part of your record with the local and state party.
